Visit Ljutomer by train, bus or choose an airline which is committed to reducing its carbon footprint. Stay with a provider that carries the eco-label and is committed to sustainability.

Nature and landscape





Visit our protected areas. As much as 5.3% of the destination's total area is included in a **Natura 2000** nature conservation area, and more than 12% is protected within the *Babji ložič* and *Ljutomerski ribniki in Jeruzalemske gorice areas*.



Ljutomer and its surroundings are ideal for exploring at a leisurely pace. Take a stroll along the well-maintained and signposted footpaths. However, be aware that leaving the marked paths may affect the biotic balance of flora and fauna.



You can also explore the hilly landscape by bike. You can rent regular or e-bikes at TIC Ljutomer and Jerusalem. There is also an automated bicycle rental system in town called *Prleški bicikl*.



Environment and climate



Experience Ljutomer as a green outdoor home. Ensure that waste is collected separately and disposed of at appropriate collection points accessible to municipal services.



Our water is clean and drinkable. Use refillable bottles for a sustainable life.



The Ljutomer area is also rich in surface water. Help conserve our water resources by taking short showers instead of baths and turning off the tap while brushing your teeth.




Choose soap and cosmetic and cleaning products that are environmentally friendly and do not harm nature or its fragile ecosystems.



Help save energy by using towels and bed linen more than once, instead of changing them immediately after the first use.



Be aware of energy and switch off electronic and other devices when they are not in use and unplug power cords from the mains.





Culture and tradition


